I. Call to Order: Rati called the council to order at 10:03 am and initiated introductions of all Council members.

The presentation was recorded and will be accessible to members if they want to refer to it while they are in the midst of their LOI reviews.
- V. Community Initiatives Update: Senaida presented a brief update on the QuickStart program. The program will be back for another round in 2022. Currently staff are conducting outreach webinars and planning for in-person outreach for early next year.
